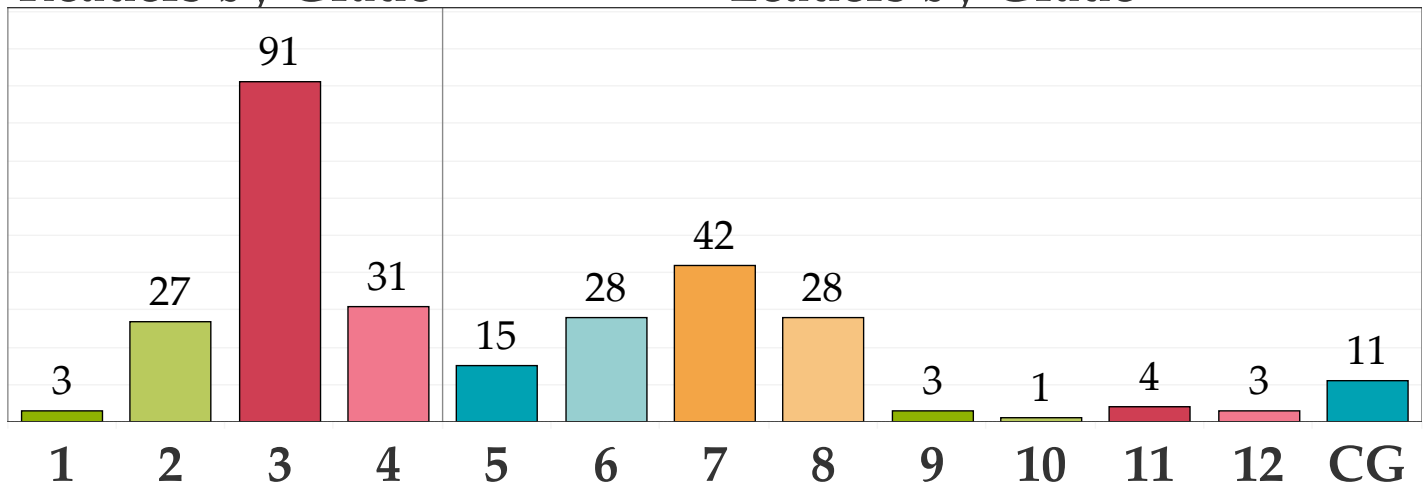

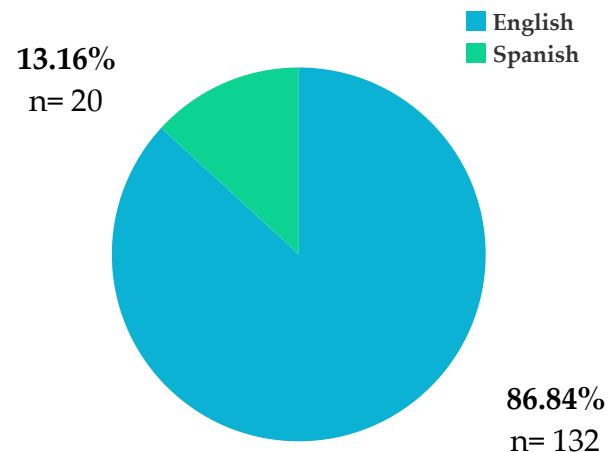

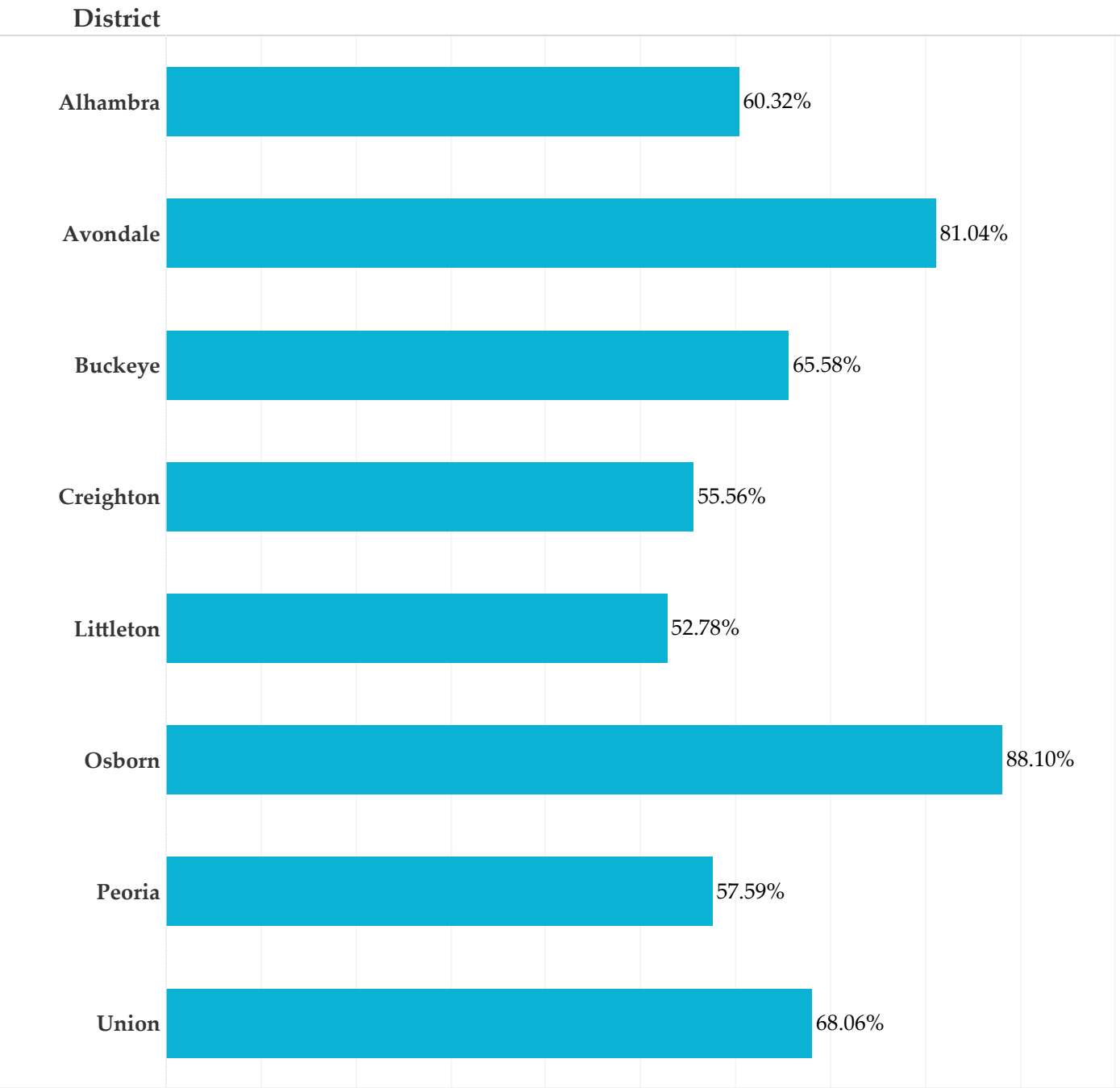

Caregiver Check-Ins were conducted weekly by RBBB Program Coaches over the phone to help guide families and facilitate the RBBB At Home program

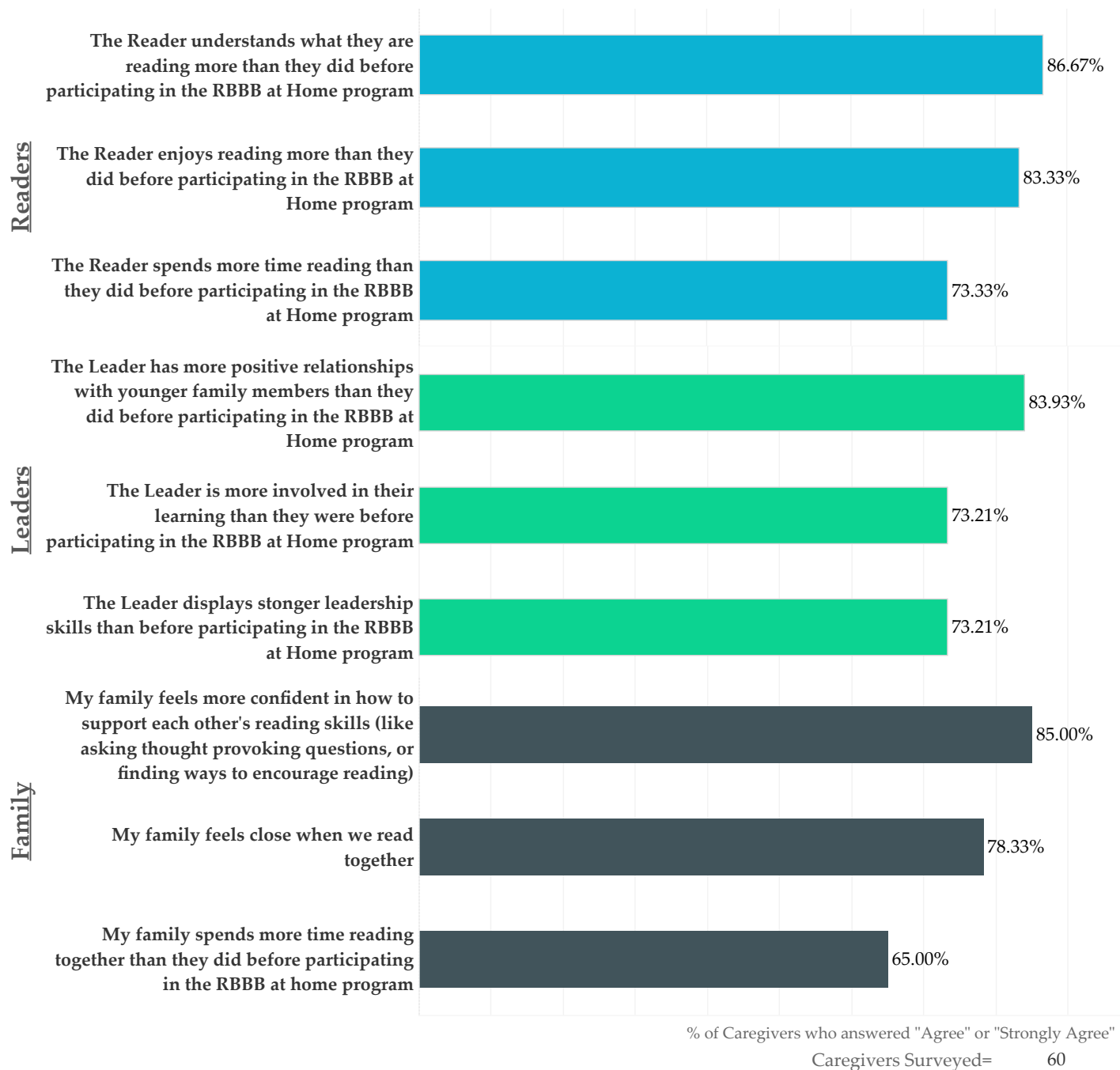


Attendance % for Readers & Leaders
